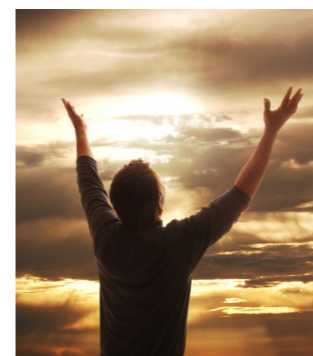

## Are you Hungry?

In a world where instant gratification and constant supply is taken for granted, we can find it very challenging when the concept of WAIT comes upon us!

Growing up we used to know such things as seasons. Apples would only be available when they "came into season", likewise with oranges. Certain foods were not available all year around.

What God has set up in the natural, is usually a shadow of what happens in the spiritual. Many of us would acknowledge that indeed our own lives have had seasons. Often we don't enjoy going through those seasons! Yet God has a purpose in allowing us to go through what we go through. Ecclesiastes 3 tells that there is a time for different things at different times.

Many of you who are a part of this ministry in some form, are hungry. You are hungry for the deeper things of God – to know Him more, to hear from Him more and ultimately do more for Him.

Yet sometimes God is telling us to wait. He may be putting us through a season of training, of learning. Or he may want us focused on our family or a particular area of ministry for a time.

I am currently studying the wonderful teachings of how to hear the voice of God by Mark Virkler. He shares that after 10 years of desperately seeking to hear God's voice, followed by one year of intense study, it finally came to pass.

If you are hungry for the things of God, continue to seek those things until they DO come to pass. We are used to instant communication, instant food, instant homes and we usually do not have to wait for much at all. Yet God will ask us to wait. However, we know that He does not withhold unnecessarily (Psalm 37:4) and will release the fullness of all He wants to give us, in the course of time.
